Langdale is a traditional bitter and was first brewed in 2009 by Cumbrian Legendary Ales brewery and since then has established itself as a firm favourite. It is now brewed every week to meet demand. Fruity refreshing 4.0% bitter with an amazing orange citrus flavour.

Loweswater Gold , Cumbria, 4.3%	1.80 / 3.50

A true golden ale from Cumbrian Legendary Ales Loweswater is brewed using three malts including lager and Maris Otter together with German hops. Bursting with tropical flavour it is an outstanding beer and has recently been judged Champion Golden Ale of Britain by CAMRA (Campaign for Real Ale) 2011.

A citrus dominated India Pale Ale from Thornbridge brewery, its immediate impression is soft and smooth yet builds to a crescendo of massive hoppiness accentuated by honey. An enduring, bitter finish.

Smokeless , Cheshire, 5.7%	2.00 / 4.00

From Red Willow brewery in Macclesfield this is a surprisingly approachable smoked porter, velvet smooth with a robust malt backbone. This is infused with chipotles to give even more smokiness and a subtle hint of heat.
